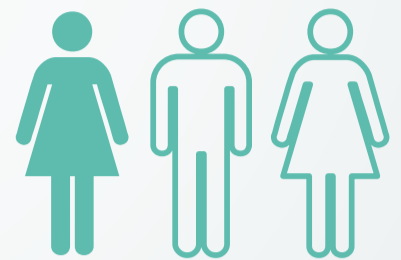

Diabetes is on the rise. **1 in 3 adults** in the USA will be diabetic by 2050.²

HEALTH COMPLICATIONS

1 in 4 diabetics develop a **diabetic foot ulcer** (DFU) within their lifetime.³



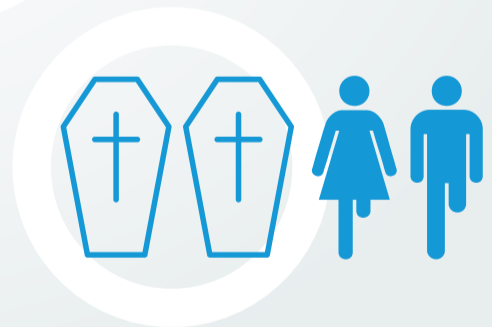
50% of all DFUs become **infected**.⁴



20% of infected DFUs result in **amputation**.⁴



50% of all patients who undergo an amputation **die within 5 years**.⁵



FINANCIAL COSTS

The global cost of diabetes set to almost **double to**

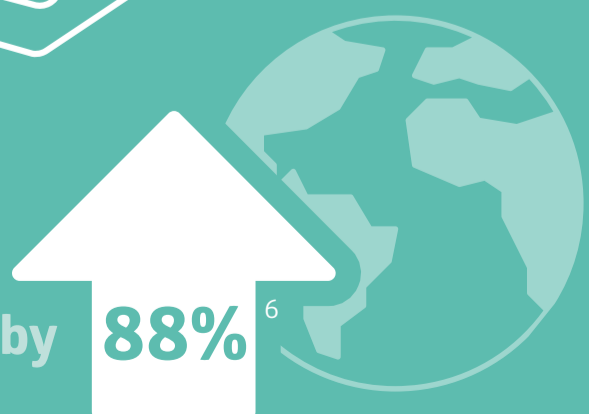
\$2.5 Trillion
